

INITIATION RESEARCH GRANT Ref^a BII 2022.06252.PTDC

Portuguese version

It is open a call for the award of a Research Grant within the scope of Project no. 2022.06252.PTDC, with the name "integrated approach for Legume promotion and sustAinable value chaiNs Development", financed by the Foundation for Science and Technology, under the conditions mentioned below.

Scientific Area: Plant Biotechnology

Admission requirements:

Candidates for the Research Grant must, at the date of application, be enrolled, or present proof of conditional enrolment, in a degree in Microbiology or related areas or in the 180 credits that correspond to the first six months of the academic curricula of an integrated master degree, or equivalent, aiming the beginning of a research training through the integration into an R&D project. Besides the already identified admission requirements, the candidates must also comply with the following specific requisites:

- Knowledge on spectrophotometric techniques for quantifying nutritional components in plant tissues/samples;

- Excellent communication, interpersonal and teamwork skills;

- High degree of rigour, autonomy and sense of responsibility

Workplan:

The work will involve the evaluation of the impact of the genetic diversity in a Portuguese collection of common bean nutritional profile through the use of spectrophotometric techniques. Namely, through the quantification of:

- T1. Protein (1 month)

- T2. Tannins (1 month)

- T3. Total antioxidant capacity (2 months)

- T4. Anthocyanins (1 month)

- T5. And results analysis and reporting (1 month).

Workplace:

The work will be developed at the CBQF-Centre for Biotechnology and Fine Chemistry integrated in the School of Biotechnology, in Porto, under the scientific guidance of Doutora Carla Santos.

Duration of the scholarship:

The scholarship, starting on April 1st, 2024, will have an initial duration of 6 months, on an exclusive basis. This scholarship may be renewed for an additional period, not exceeding the end of the project schedule for 28.02.2026 and the duration of this scholarship typology, 12 months.

Amount of the monthly maintenance allowance:

The value of the scholarship corresponds to € 601.12 according to the values of the research grants awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the Country (https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/Tabela-de-Valores-SMM_atualizacao-2024.pdf) and will be paid by bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection methods to be used will be the following: i) curricular evaluation (40%); ii) previous experience (60%). The final decision, if necessary, may involve interviews with the highest positioned candidates, and in this situation the weighting will be: i) curricular evaluation (35%); ii) previous experience (50%); and iii) selection interview (15%).

Applications that do not meet the admission requirements, are not submitted on time and incomplete applications will be considered illegible. It is mandatory to present the degree certificate with the respective final classifications.







Only candidates with a final classification equal to or greater than seventy points, on a scale of 0 to 100, will be selected for this position.

Form of publicity / notification of results:

The jury deliberates according to the selection criteria adopted and disclosed. The report of the jury meetings shall contain a summary of the content of the meeting. After the application of the selection criteria, the jury proceeds to the preparation of the ordered list, with the ordering of the successful candidates. The ranking list of eligible candidates will be published at the premises of the Portuguese Catholic University in Porto, located at Rua de Diogo Botelho, 1327, 4169-005 Porto - Portugal, and each candidate will be notified of their position in the list of candidates via e-mail. Ineligible applicants will be notified by email, with details of the missing eligibility elements.

Complaint and redress procedures:

Candidates have a period of ten working days, after the disclosure referred to in the previous paragraph, to manifest themselves in a prior hearing.

Deadline for acceptance of the scholarship:

Within ten working days after notification of the award of the scholarship, the selected candidate must confirm in writing his availability to start the scholarship on the proposed date. If you do not do so or do not have availability, the candidate placed in the next position will be called.

Deadline for registration and form of submission:

Applications will be accepted from February 16th, 2024 until March 02nd, 2024, 23:59, (Lisbon time).

- 1. Cover letter, identifying the title and reference of the project, describing the motivation and professional goals of the candidate.

- 3. Record of recognition of academic degrees awarded by foreign higher education institutions and record of the conversion of the corresponding final classification to the Portuguese classification scale. 1
- 4. Proof of enrollment in a Higher Education Institution in study cycles conferring an academic degree under the terms described in the notice..

Only applications received during the opening period of the said competition will be considered. Candidates who incorrectly formalize their application or who do not prove the requirements of this competition are excluded. False statements made by candidates will be punished under the law.
