

RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS Refa clabel_BI_PPS4-1

Portuguese version

A tender is now open for the attribution of <u>two</u> Research Grants under the project "cLabel+: Innovative "clean label" natural, nutritious and consumer-oriented foods" (POCI-01-0247-FEDER-046080), co-financed by the Fund European Regional Development (ERDF) through the Competitiveness and Internationalization Operational Program (POCI), under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Agro-food, Sensory evaluation and consumer studies

Admission requirements:

Applicants for the research grant must have a Master's degree in Food Science or Engineering, Consumer Studies, Biotechnology or similar area. Applicants for the Research Grant must also be enrolled or commit to enrolling in a course that does not confer an academic degree, that promotes the consolidation of their scientific training ¹. Candidates must be able to communicate in Portuguese and are fluent in English. Candidates should possess knowledge/experience in sensory evaluation, development, characterization and validation of food products - chemical, physical (texture), microbiological and sensory attributes.

Work plan:

The activity to be developed by the fellow is part of a research project whose main goal is to develop processes and products that are perceived by consumers as consistent with products with natural ingredients, with limited use of a large number of additives, and that allow, by their physical, chemical and nutritional properties, provide the expected experience, while maintaining food safety. The specific objective is to characterize and validate the optimized formulations.

The research fellow will participate in the experimental tasks of the project, collection and analysis of research data, and writing of articles.

Work place:

The work will be developed at the CBQF - Center for Biotechnology and Fine Chemistry of the Universidade Católica Portuguesa - School of Biotechnology, under the scientific guidance of Prof. Ana Gomes, Prof. Manuela Pintado and Prof. Paula Teixeira.

Duration of scholarship(s):

The scholarship scheduled to start on 01/03/2023 and will last for 3 months on an exclusive basis.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €1144,64 € according to the table of values of the scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the country (https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores.phtml.pt) and will be paid by bank transfer.

Selection methods:

The selection methods to be used will be the following: i) curriculum assessment (50%); ii) previous experience (50%). The final decision, if necessary, may involve an interview with the best positioned candidates, and in this situation, the weighting will be curricular evaluation (35%); ii) previous experience (35%) and selection interview (30%).

Composition of the Selection Jury: President of the Jury: Prof. Manuela Pintado; Members: Prof. Paula Teixeira and Doutora Maria João Monteiro; Substitute: Doutora Joana Barbosa

Form of publicity/notification of results: The jury deliberates according to the selection criteria adopted and disclosed. The jury's meetings are recorded in minutes that contain a summary of what took place in them. After completing the application of the selection criteria, the jury proceeds to prepare the ranked list, in order of ranking of eligible candidates. The ranking list of eligible candidates will be posted on the premises of the Universidade Católica Portuguesa, in Porto, located at Rua de Diogo Botelho, 1327, 4169-005 Porto - Portugal, each candidate being notified of their position on the list classification via email. Ineligible candidates will be notified by email, explaining the missing eligibility elements.

Complaint and appeal procedures: Candidates have a period of ten working days, after the disclosure referred to in the previous number, to comment, in the context of a prior hearing.

Deadline for acceptance of the scholarship: Within ten working days following the notification of the scholarship award, the selected candidate must confirm in writing their availability to start the scholarship on the proposed date. Not doing so or not having availability, the candidate placed in the next position will be called.









Form of submission and deadline for applications:

Applications will be accepted January 25th, 2023, until February 08th, 2023, at 23:59 (Lisbon time). Applications must be sent by email to: drh.recrutamento.porto@ucp.pt, identifying in the subject of the email "Application to the competition with the reference "Ref=" cLabel BI PPS4-1"

You will need to submit the following documents:

- 1. Cover letter, identifying the title and reference of the project, describing the candidate's motivation and professional goals;
- 2. Detailed Curriculum Vitae (should contain all the elements that allow the assessment of admission requirements, namely language skills and research experience).
- 3. Copy of the certificate(s) of qualifications conferring academic degree in the terms requested in the notice, which contain the final classifications.
- 4. Registration of recognition of the academic degree awarded by a foreign higher education institution, preferably with the registration of the conversion of the respective final classification to the Portuguese classification scale to guarantee eligibility in this call for application.²
- 5. Proof of enrollment in a course not leading to an academic degree or
- 6. Declaration of commitment to enroll in a course that does not lead to an academic degree under the terms referred to in the admission requirements.

Candidates who incorrectly formalize their application or who do not prove the requirements of this competition are excluded from admission to the competition. False statements made by candidates will be punished under the law.
