A tender is now open for the attribution of a Research Grant under the project **LIFE Fitting: Demonstration of an innovative PLAN-DO toolbox for a safer, resource efficient and fit-forpurpose wastewater treatment**, GA 101114188, funded by the European Commission, LIFE Programme, under the following conditions, under the following conditions:

Scientific Area: Microbiology

Admission requirements:

Applicants must have higher academic qualifications in the scientific area Microbiology or related areas. The candidate should demonstrate interest in the scientific area and have an ability to develop team work in a multidisciplinary and multicultural environment. It is essential that the candidates have good command of the English language and research experience in Environmental Microbiology, Molecular Biology.

Applicants for the Research grant must also be enrolled or commit to enrolling in a course that does not confer an academic degree that promotes the consolidation of their scientific training¹.

Work plan:

Processing and microbiological analysis of wastewater and surface water, based on cultivation methods and independent of cultivation.

Workplace:

The work will be developed at CBQF-Centro de Biotecnologia e Química Fina integrated in Escola Superior de Biotecnologia, at Universidade Católica Portuguesa in Porto, under the supervision of Célia Manaia

Duration of scholarship(s):

The scholarship, starting on October 1, 2023, will have an initial duration of six months, on an exclusive basis. This scholarship may be renewed for an additional period of 6 months.

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the scholarship corresponds to €1104.64 according to the table of values of the scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in the country (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores.phtml.pt>) and will be paid by bank transfer.

Selection Methods:

The selection methods to be used will be the following: i) curriculum assessment (40%); ii) previous experience (60%). If necessary, the 3 best positioned candidates may be interviewed, and in this situation, the weighting will be curricular evaluation (25%); ii) previous experience (60%) and selection interview (15%).

Only candidates with a final classification equal to or greater than seventy-five points, on a scale of 0 to 100, will be selected for this position.

Composition of the Selection Jury: President of the Jury: Prof. Doutora Célia Manaia; Effective Members: Doutora Ivone Vaz-Moreira; Dra. Cristina Mena; Substitute: Prof. Doutora Manuela Pintado.

Form of publicity/notification of results: The jury deliberates according to the selection criteria adopted and disclosed. The jury's meetings are recorded in minutes that contain a summary of what

took place in them. After completing the application of the selection criteria, the jury proceeds to prepare the ranked list, in order of ranking of eligible candidates. The ranking list of eligible candidates will be posted on the premises of the Universidade Católica Portuguesa, in Porto, located at Rua de Diogo Botelho, 1327, 4169-005 Porto - Portugal, each candidate being notified of their position on the list classification via email. Ineligible candidates will be notified by email, explaining the missing eligibility elements.

Complaint and appeal procedures: Candidates have a period of ten working days, after the disclosure referred to in the previous number, to comment, in the context of a prior hearing.

Deadline for acceptance of the scholarship: Within ten working days following the notification of the scholarship award, the selected candidate must confirm in writing their availability to start the scholarship on the proposed date. Not doing so or not having availability, the candidate placed in the next position will be called.

You will need to submit the following documents:

1. Motivation letter, identifying the project title and reference, describing the candidate's motivation and professional goals;
2. Detailed Curriculum Vitae (should contain all elements to assess admission requirements, including language skills and research experience);
3. Copy of the Master's certificate, with the final classifications
4. Registration of recognition of the academic degree awarded by a foreign higher education institution, preferably with the registration of the conversion of the respective final classification to the Portuguese classification scale to guarantee eligibility in this call for application².

² If the Master Degree has been awarded by a non-Portuguese higher education institution it must comply with the provisions of the Portuguese legislation on the recognition of foreign degrees, regulated by Decree-Law no. 66/2018 of August 16th. The signature of the contract is conditional on the presentation of the formal document.

5. Proof of enrollment in a course that does not lead to an academic degree or Declaration of commitment to enroll in a course that does not lead to an academic degree under the terms referred to in the admission requirements.

Candidates present their candidacy under the terms mentioned in the previous point, **from July 28, 2023 until September 03, 2023 (until 17:00, Lisbon time)**.

Candidates who incorrectly formalize their application or who do not prove the requirements of this competition are excluded from admission to the competition. False statements made by candidates will be punished under the law.
